

Cambria-Friesland School District **Reopening Process & Procedures**

Masking/Face Coverings: Starting July 26, 2021 face mask coverings are strongly recommended for all students, staff, volunteers and visitors who are unvaccinated.

All recommendations as listed below are the same recommendations the district followed at the end of the 2020-2021 school year.

*Except:

- Family members, siblings, do not have to quarantine from school if a family member is presenting COVID-19 symptoms.
- If you are fully vaccinated (it has been at least two weeks since you have finished your vaccine series) and you do not have any COVID-19 symptoms, you do not have to get tested or quarantined after close contact with a person with COVID-19.

COVID-19 Symptoms: Student/Staff Stay home if:

- One or more of the following symptoms are present:
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath
 - Difficulty breathing

OR

- Two or more of the following symptoms are present:
 - Congestion
 - Runny nose
 - Fever or chills
 - Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
 - Headache
 - Fatigue, muscle aches or body aches
 - Sore throat

- **Return -**
 - Negative COVID-19 test
 - 10 day isolation - may return to school if symptom free for 24 hours without medication.
 - Families - Siblings - can stay in school if not experiencing symptoms themselves.

Close Contact: Indoors, less than 6 feet.

- Vaccinated student, staff, and visitors: If you are fully vaccinated (it has been at least two weeks since you have finished your vaccine series) and you do not have any COVID-19 symptoms, you do not have to get tested or quarantined after close contact with a person with COVID-19.
- Unvaccinated student, staff, and visitors: Test day 6 or after, return with a negative test.

Positive COVID-19:

- Same procedure as 2020-2021
- 10 day isolation - may return to school if symptom free for 24 hours without medication.
